10: 30 Operational Excellence Mini Master Class "How to establish Reliability as a core value in your Organisation"

Reliable Manufacturing presents a half day Mini Master Class exploring the strategies and practices that underpin some of the world's best operating companies.

The Master Class will describe models for achieving Operations Excellence and will show how the best plants are able to compete globally through the application of a Reliability Strategy; one which combines the best elements of Lean Manufacturing, TPM, RCM, six sigma and other methodologies as well as excellence in operations and maintenance practices.

13:30 Managing Reliability - Half Day Workshop

This half day workshop is designed to provide an understanding of the RCM method of maintenance task optimisation. Participants will gain an understanding of the use of failure data analysis and failure forecasting and how to choose optimum maintenance tasks that reduce the costs to the business.

Some of the course topics addressed in the workshop are:

- Why traditional maintenance cannot meet the needs of business today
- What is RCM?
- How to identify failure modes that can impact your plant
- How to calculate failure data relevant to your equipment using Weibul
- Assessing the total cost impact of failure on a business
- How preventive maintenance and predictive maintenance improve business, safety, environment and operational risks
- Simulating the maintenance strategy
 How to select the optimum maintenance task and frequency

From a Leadership perspective we will show you how to develop and implement an effective strategy for engaging all of your staff in defect elimination and creating a co-operative working environment, where people from all departments and levels in the Organisation work together to solve problems.

10: 30 Apollo RCA - Half Day Workshop

The Apollo Root Cause AnalysisTM method is a new way of thinking that goes far beyond the traditional root cause analysis problem solving processes. It facilitates the creation of a common reality, using input from all stakeholders to produce an evidence-based understanding of the problem and ensures your solutions address proven causes and prevents recurrence. This half day workshop will present the Apollo process in more detail and share some practical case studies in its use and application.

13:30 Lubrication Workshop

Experience in implementing Lubrication practices with manufacturing plants, have shown significant reductions in the replacement Bearing spend and the amount of Lubricants consumed. The Lubrication activity can today be regarded as one of the most important ingredients in achieving a standard in World Class Maintenance. This presentation explains the connection between lubrication activities and their direct effect on plant and equipment reliability. There are many and varied theories on what is a good Lubrication strategy, however this experienced based presentation pulls together the industry Best Practices in Lubrication activities and defines the statement "What is Lubrication Reliability and what are the Best Practice steps to achieve it." There is a growing recognition in industry of the positive effects that an improved lubrication strategy or practice will bring to plant reliability issues, however not all companies that attempt to implement such practices, succeed in achieving the benefits anticipated. This presentation explores the dangers or traps industry or management can fall into with such initiatives and shows the changes management needs to address to avoid failure.
